Snow Day e-Learning Plan for Students

Expectations:

- Complete the Google Attendance Form sent via email on the morning of the school closure.
- Assignments will be posted on Google Classroom or emailed by 9:00 a.m on the day of school closure. There should be a learning activity for each class that your child has on that day.
- Teachers will be available via email on the e-learning day until 2:00 p.m.
- If you are having any problems with logging on or technology, please email Mrs. Girten at kgirten@evdio.org or Mr. Schuler at mschuler@evdio.org.
- When the School Messenger call comes through announcing an e-learning day, Mrs. Girten will also announce when the assignments are due. Students will be given multiple days to turn in the learning assignments.
- If a family does not have access to internet on the e-learning day, you will need to notify the teacher or Mrs. Girten. The media center may be used once school is back in session.
- In order for a student to receive credit for attendance on the virtual learning day, the student/ family must complete the Google attendance form during the e-learning window and complete all assignments.
